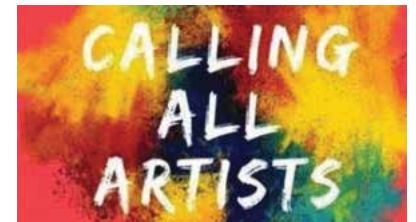
Tullahoma Art Center Update
